

Dress Code

Our dress code is designed to allow the instructor an unobstructed view of a dancer's alignment and technique. It also aids in maintaining a professional, disciplined atmosphere.

All dancers are required to follow the dress code or they will not be able to participate in class. The first time they are not dressed properly, a note will be sent home as a reminder.

Hair must be pulled back off the face and neck and neatly secured. No gum, jewelry or watches are allowed.

Ballet, Creative Movement, Fairytale Ballet, Ballet/Tap Combo

- Solid color leotard (no t-shirts, tank tops, etc)
- Pink footed-tights
- Pink ballet shoes (laces tucked into shoes or cut off, straps sewn on)
- Ballet skirt (optional – no longer than top of thigh)
- No tutus, old costumes or slippers

Jazz

- Solid color leotard (no t-shirts, tank tops, etc)
- Black jazz pants or black dance capris (no gaucho pants or shorts)
- Black jazz shoes

Tap

- Solid color leotard (no t-shirts, tank tops, etc)
- Black jazz pants or black dance capris (no gaucho pants or shorts)
- Black tap shoes

Hip-Hop

- Solid color leotard or solid color tank top
- Black jazz pants or black dance capris (no gaucho pants or shorts)
- Black jazz shoes (no jazz sneakers or street shoes)

Modern

- Solid color leotard (no t-shirts, tank tops, etc)
- Black dance capris or black dance shorts (no gaucho pants)

Boys

- Solid color t-shirt (form-fitting)
- Black jazz pants or black sweatpants (no shorts)
- See above classes for shoe requirements
