

BALLET BUN TUTORIAL

TIP: Start with clean, detangled hair for easy to manage hair.

1. Begin by lightly misting the front area of the hairline with water or hairspray. Brush the hair toward the back of the head.
2. Next, start gathering the hair in one hand while continuing to brush the hair straight back.
3. Using a fine tooth comb, smooth out the hair, gathering the hair into the holding hand at the crown of the head.

4. Secure the hair into a tight ponytail (for thicker hair, you may need to use 2 hair ties).

METHOD 1:

- Twist the ponytail until it wraps around the base of the ponytail and secure with hairpins.
- Once secured, cover the bun with a hairnet. Secure the net with pins.

METHOD 2:

- Split the ends of the ponytail into 2 sections.
- Twist the sections going the same direction.
- Wrap the twists around the base of the ponytail and secure with hairpins.
- Once secured, cover the bun with a hairnet. Secure the net with pins.



5. Finish the look with a liberal dose of hairspray or gel to smooth out any stray hair.

About Placement: A well-placed bun will accentuate and flatter your facial structure. To find the true crown of the head, draw an imaginary line from the corner of your mouth, along your cheekbone and over your ear to the back of the head.
